He was principal oboist of the National Symphony Orchestra of Mexico from 1992 to 2008

Born in Orizaba, Veracruz, Mexico, in 1967.

At age 15, he fell in love with the oboe and began his studies at the Faculty of Music of the University of Veracruz, where he worked under the tutelage of Roland Dufrane, and later in Mexico City with Dutch oboist Maarten Dekkers.

From 1992 to 1995, he completed training courses in London, England, with the renowned oboist and teacher Michael Winfield (London Symphony Orchestra & Royal College of Music).

Since 2008 he has lived in Amsterdam, Holland as an independent musician.

Since 2019 he has been playing with Gerard van Zeijl (Organ & Oboe) with whom he has a YouTube channel with the music played during religious services.

Geboren 1960, studeerde Propaedeuse Accountancy, Klinische Psychologie, Politicologie, Staatsexamen theoretische vakken van de muziek en van 1997 tot 2004 bij Jos van der Kooy aan het conservatorium te Alkmaar kerkorgel en kerkmuziek, verder Koordirectie en piano als bijvak. Werkt als pianodocent en koordirigent van verschillende koren en als organist in verschillende kerken. Sinds 2019 als duo werkzaam.
